


The Story of Chartwells Workers at DePaul University

Chartwells employee average annual earnings (2019)	\$25,033

DePaul University depends on employees of Chartwells to welcome visitors to campus and keep undergraduates well fed. Chartwells is contracted by the University to provide dining services in the Lincoln Park Student Center, the McGowan Cafe and at the Loop Campus Student Center.

Compass Group, Chartwells' parent company, is a global service company with \$26 billionⁱⁱⁱ in underlying revenue for the year ending Sept. 30, 2020. The 2019 average annual earnings for Chartwells employees at DePaul University was \$25,033^{iv}, less than the U.S poverty guideline for a family of four.^v

According to the MIT Living Wage Calculator, in 2021 a single adult with one child would have to earn \$67,080 per year to support him or herself in the Chicago Metropolitan Statistical Area.^{vi}

UNITE HERE surveyed Chartwells workers at DePaul University in June, July, and August of 2021.

The 65 respondents reported the following.vii

How do Chartwells workers at DePaul University survive?

- 49% lack enough money to pay their bills
- 85% have less than \$1,000 in savings
- 48% owe \$1,000 or more, not including a mortgage
- 49% receive government welfare program benefits





Chartwells workers at DePaul University are food insecure

- 40% cannot afford healthy food for their families
- 17% have household members who have gone hungry this year
- 43% went to a food pantry this year

Chartwells Workers at DePaul face barriers to healthcare

- 15% of respondents, or a member of their household, could not afford to go to the doctor
- 11% of respondents, or a member of their household, could not afford their medications
- 18% of respondents, or a member of their household, skipped some kind of medical service
